In consideration of permission being granted to SLATERS FC (Hosting Organization) to hold a tournament or games at NEWPORT BEACH (City), CA (State) on the dates of JULY 19-20, 2008

we agree to the following conditions:

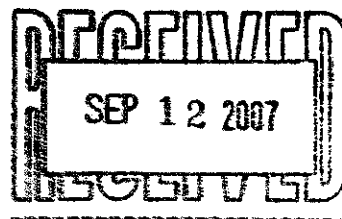
1. **ABIDE BY RULES:** We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer *Application to Host A Tournament or Games*, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer *Travel and Tournament Policy* and in this US Youth Soccer *Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement*. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin.
2. **INVITATIONS:** The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed us.
3. **PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE:** We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member, US Youth Soccer and their officers and directors as additional insureds. A copy of the certificate of insurance is attached issued by CAL SOUTH.
4. **REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS:** We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical authorizations for each player in a form adequate for use at the site of the tournament or games. These authorizations shall be presented to the Hosting Organization at registration and kept at the field available for use by the team.
5. **ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES:** We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.
6. **CREDENTIALS CHECKS:** We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks (check one)—
 - a. at registration,
 - b. at the field prior to each game by a field marshal, or
 - c. at both sites,
 to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer *Application to Host a Tournament or Games*.
7. **USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES:** We agree that we shall, in accordance with US Soccer Bylaw 532, use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system. We intend to use a 3-referee system for the following age groups: U11-U19. There will be an adequate number of US Soccer registered referees available in the area during the tournament or game dates to cover the scheduled games. 8. **USE OF FIELD MARSHALS - FIELD INSPECTION:** We agree that during the tournament or games each game field will have a field marshal assigned to it at all times; that the field marshal will be readily available and identifiable; that prior to the commencement of every game the field marshal will inspect the field to be sure that it is free from objects or conditions that may cause injury. 9. **USE OF SPECTATOR LINES:** We agree to take appropriate steps including, where feasible, the use of spectator lines on each field to keep the spectators off the touch line.

11. **AVAILABILITY OF POLICE AND RESCUE SERVICE:** We have notified the local police, ambulance, and emergency rescue services of the date of the tournament or games and the times and fields which will be used for games, and have been advised by them that they will be available to render assistance if needed.

12. **TOURNAMENT OR GAME RULES – BEHAVIOR:** We agree that our tournament or game rules contain provisions ensuring that the behavior of teams, players, coaches, and spectators is appropriately controlled, including specific provisions that—
a. spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
b. indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
c. indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
d. record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
e. state that the home State Association or Affiliate and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

13. **TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION:** We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.

14. **POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT:** We agree that we shall file a Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report shall preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:

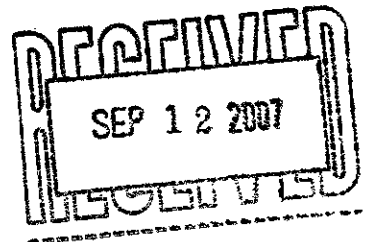
- a. the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- b. if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- c. the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- d. if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- e. the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- f. the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- g. the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsportsmanlike conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official, or other incidents of a serious nature, must be reported to the alleged offender's club or league and home State Association, Affiliate, or other Organization Member immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse.**

USYS & CYSA Approval | Hotel C

This Tournament shall be played under FIFA rules as modified by USYSA and CYSA-S. All decisions and calls tournament referees are final. No Protests will be allowed. The designated Field Marshall or Tournament Dir will resolve any situation not covered by the rules.

Registration:

Teams must check-in in accordance with instructions provided with acceptance. All players must be register with USYS (*i.e. CYSA, US Club, etc.*) and have their laminated league passes and medical release forms. **P. CARDS CAN BE FROM THE CURRENT SEASON, THE NEW SEASON OR A MIX OF BOTH.** A team is allowed up to 5 loan players with appropriate papers. There will be no player additions after check

Game Check In:

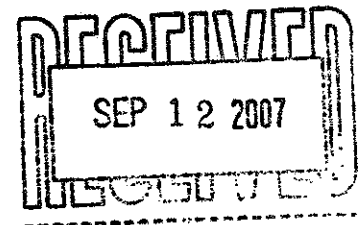
The Field Marshall or Referee will check player I.D. cards and equipment prior to each game. Players must wear shin guards to play. Home Team is listed first in the schedule and will have choice of sides. In case of conflict home team must change jerseys. Home team will supply the game ball. Failure to have 7 players available 5 minutes of scheduled game time constitutes a forfeit. The winner will be awarded 8 points. (6 for the win, a goal, 1 for no goals scored against.)

Game Length:

Preliminary & Semi-finals: Game length for U-9 through U-14 will be 25-minute halves. U15 through U19 will be 30-minute halves. Five minutes for half time. Finals will be regulation time. There will be no time allowance for injuries.

Format:

1. 6 Points for each win
2. 3 Points for each tie.
3. Zero points for a loss
4. 1 Point for a shutout.
5. 1 Point for each goal scored up to a maximum of 3 per game.
6. Minus 1 point for each player or coach ejected (red carded).
7. No shutout bonus point for a 0-0 tie.



Tie Breakers:

If teams are tied on points after preliminary games, the following tiebreaker system will be used to determine quarter-finalists, semi-finalists and finalists as may be applicable:

1. Head-to-head competition
2. Goal differential

3. Goals allowed
4. Goals scored
5. FIFA penalty kicks.

The same will also be used to determine Champions & Finalists for those brackets playing Round Robin form where there is no final.

Overtime will not be played in any preliminary & semi-final games. Semi-finals will go directly to shoot-out. will have two 5-minute overtimes and a shoot out if required.

Substitutions:

Substitutions may be made, with the consent of the referee, at any stoppage in play.

Awards:

Winner shall be presented with Team Championship trophy and individual awards will be presented to both after the championship match.

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their players, bench & spectators, and may be ejected based on conduct of those for whom the coach is responsible. Any player or coach ejected from a game will not be permitted to play in the next scheduled match unless agreed to by the Tournament Committee.

Refund Policy:

Refunds will be made to all teams not accepted. Teams that drop before June 10th will be given refunds. No refunds will be given to teams that drop after June 10th.

The Tournament Director or referee may suspend any match or tournament in consideration of safety to players or damage to fields in event of inclement weather under any circumstances. Partial refunds for cancelled or suspended games will be considered by Tournament Committee and determined in full accordance with CYSA-S guidelines or rules and regulations but will not exceed \$100 per game.

No refund will be allowed due to forfeit of game by team accepted to tournament.

Application to Slammers Futbol Classic does not automatic acceptance to the tournament. Full Refunds will be given to any team not accepted into the tournament.

The Tournament Director has the authority to make decisions on any matters not specifically covered by the rules & regulations.
